### EXPERIENCE THE SEA-TO-SKY

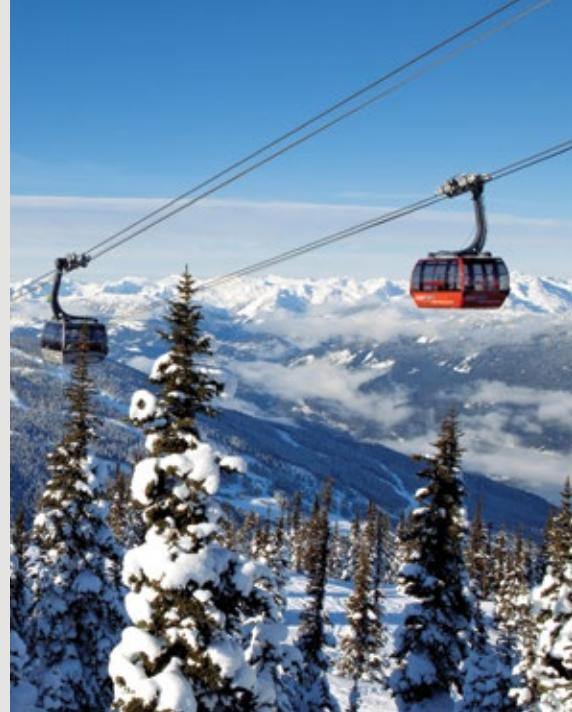

Or, take an adrenaline-fueled passenger bobsleigh ride together with your group at the Whistler Sliding Centre. You'll accelerate down the track at 125km/hr — just like the athletes did.

### SKI TWO MOUNTAINS IN ONE DAY

Whistler's two side-by-side mountains are connected by the epic PEAK 2 PEAK Gondola, the longest and highest unsupported lift system on the planet, which changes the way you ski Whistler Blackcomb. Ski Whistler in the morning and ride 7th Heaven on Blackcomb after lunch and experience the mind-blowing terrain of North America's #1 Ski Resort.

### RAISE A GLASS AT APRÈS

## DAY 3

Alternatively, discover the Audain Art Museum, which highlights the richness of Canada's cultural and art heritage, right in the heart of Whistler Village.

### FIND A WINTER WONDERLAND

Glide through the snow on Blackcomb Mountain on an unforgettable horse-drawn sleigh ride. Keep warm with a hot drink and cozy blankets while exploring under the starry night sky. After the tour, warm yourself by a crackling wood fire. Then, enjoy a delicious fondue dinner.

## DAY 4

### SOAR LIKE AN EAGLE

Feel the rush of adrenaline as you fly through the forest, high above the glacial rapids of Fitzsimmons Creek. Host a canapé party and zipline from gourmet station to station. Here, you can bring your group together in Whistler's towering old-growth forests, a place where team building and an appetite for fun come with the territory.

### SOAK UP THE SCENERY

Set in a secluded spruce and cedar forest, the Scandinave Spa is the ideal place to rejuvenate and unwind. Soothing outdoor baths, refreshing waterfalls and Finnish saunas will leave you feeling relaxed and restored. The spa is a perfect group alternative to some of Whistler's high-adrenaline adventures.

### CELEBRATE IN THE CENTRE

Celebrations go bigger at the Whistler Conference Centre. This centrally located space has over 40,000 square feet of versatile meeting space, steeped in Whistler tradition as a place to host gala events, concerts, ice performances, film festivals, tradeshow and more.

### LEAD THE PACK

Be pulled through Whistler's wilderness by a team of spirited sled dogs in this quintessentially Canadian experience. Cozy into the blanketed sled as your pack of huskies dash through the dramatic landscape. Ready to kick it up a notch? Take the reins and try being a musher.
