COMPETITOR INFORMATION

- Whistler will welcome approximately 400 competitors from 23 nations for the Whistler-specific events.
- The Whistler Conference Centre is a gathering hub for competitors and their friends/family.



Competitors will be based overnight in Vancouver and transported to and from Whistler daily. Competitors will be transported directly to competition venues, and/or Whistler Village.

MEDIA

- The Games has a total of 280 accredited media.
- The Whistler Media Centre is the Whistler Conference Centre (lower level). Access is for accredited Media only.

SPORT COMPETITION ACCESS

- **Sport competition locations:** Whistler Olympic Park, Whistler Sliding Centre, Whistler Mountain
- Live event viewing: Sport events take place from Feb 10-12 and are FREE to spectate, with some alpine events requiring a Whistler Blackcomb sightseeing or lift pass to access (details below).
 - Whistler Sliding Centre: Skeleton (Feb 10 & 11) Spectators can catch the Excalibur Gondola for free to the Whistler Sliding Centre from Whistler Village. No onsite parking available. Alternatively, guests can drive up to parking lots 6, 7, & 8 and make their way across to the Whistler Sliding Centre.
 - Whistler Olympic Park: Nordic Cross-Country Skiing & Biathlon (Feb 11) Spectators will have free access to the Whistler Olympic Park. To get there, spectators will need to make their own way to the Whistler Olympic Park via private transport, car or taxi. Free onsite parking is available at the venue (P2 Parking Lot). A free shuttle will run from the venue parking lot, to and from the biathlon competition.
 - Whistler Mountain (Upper Fantastic): Alpine Skiing & Snowboarding Novice (Feb 11) Spectators with a Whistler Blackcomb sightseeing, lift ticket or seasons pass can take the Whistler Village Gondola to Olympic Station or ride down to the event from the top of Whistler Mountain.
 Spectators without a pass can watch the race onscreen from the viewing locations.
 - Whistler Mountain Alpine (Lower Olympic): Alpine Skiing & Snowboarding Intermediate Advanced (Feb 12) Spectators with a Whistler Blackcomb lift ticket or seasons pass can catch some of the action by riding down to view the races. Spectators without a pass can watch from the finish line in Skier's Plaza.

Event screenings:

- The Maury Young Arts Centre and Village Square stage will screen the events for all to enjoy.
- The Invictus YouTube channel will stream the events, with daily highlights on TSN.

Venue operational impacts:

- o Whistler Gondola Access
 - Upload: Higher traffic is expected on Monday and Tuesday between 8:30 9:30 AM.
 Guests are encouraged to use alternative routes to access the mountain, including the Excalibur Gondola, Fitzsimmons Express Chairlift, Blackcomb Gondola, or Creekside Gondola during these times.



- Download: Anticipate longer-than-usual wait times for downloading at Olympic Station. Guests are advised to ski down Whistler or upload to the Peak-2-Peak Gondola and download via Blackcomb Mountain.
- Whistler Mountain Upper Fantastic will be closed on February 10 & 11. Lower Olympic will be closed on February 11 & 12. There will be no lift closures.
- Whistler Sliding Centre Passenger Bobsleigh and Public Skeleton will not be available from January 30 February 12.
- The GLC Restaurant will be closed to the public from February 10 12. Increased traffic expected at Pika's Café on Whistler Mountain during the games.
- The bubly Tube Park Will be fully booked from 10:30 AM 12:30 PM and 1:30 3 PM on February
 10 & 12 and again from 10:30 AM 12:30 PM and 4 6 PM on February 11.

ENTERTAINMENT: WHISTLER INVICTUS VILLAGE

- The "Whistler Invictus Village" will be a buzzing area of activations and entertainment throughout the Village Stroll from February 9-13.
- Entertainment lineup: The Whistler Invictus Mainstage (located at Village Square) line up & schedule is available online.
- Programming is scheduled in four areas:
 - Whistler Olympic Plaza Winter sport trials and partner activations including merchandise sales.
 - Maury Young Arts Centre Family fun zone including sport competition viewing, the Veterans Art Show exhibition, face painting, arts & crafts, and more.
 - Village Square Sport competition viewing, merchandise sales, and daily concerts from 2:30 5
 PM
 - Mountain Square Partner activations including samples and giveaways

- Paid parking is available in Day Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.
- Free parking is available in Day Lots 6, 7 & 8. Parking is limited. Visitors can catch the Excalibur Gondola for free between the hours of 8:30 AM 3:30 PM provided they are not wearing ski or snowboard gear with equipment. Pets will not be permitted.
- Electric vehicle charging information.
- Parking for events at Whistler Olympic Park is available onsite. It is approximately a 26-minute drive to Whistler Olympic Park from Whistler Village.

GENERAL INVICTUS GAMES QUESTIONS

- 1. What is the Invictus Games?
 - An international sporting event for wounded, injured, and sick service members and Veterans. The
 Games use the power of sport to inspire recovery, support rehabilitation and generate a wider
 understanding of and respect forall those who serve or have served their country.
- 2. What does 'Invictus' mean?
 - Means 'Unconquered'
 - The term embodies the fighting spirit of the participating men and women, as well as their motivation to move on with their lives, to gain a new place in life, and to not let themselves be defined by the trauma they have suffered.
- 3. When are the Invictus Games 2025 taking place?
 - The Games are taking place in Vancouver and Whistler this February.
- 4. Where in Whistler are the Invictus Games 2025 taking place?
 - The sport competitions in Whistler are taking place at the Whistler Sliding Centre (Skeleton), on Whistler Mountain (Alpine Skiing & Snowboarding) and at Whistler Olympic Park (Cross Country Skiing and Biathlon).
- 5. What Nations are attending the Invictus Games 2025?
 - A record 23 Nations will compete in the Invictus Games Vancouver Whistler 2025. The list of Nations can be found at invictusgames2025.ca
- 6. How many people are competing at the Invictus Games 2025?
 - 532 Competitors are competing at the 2025 Invictus Games
 - 1100 Family & Friends will also be here to cheer on and support their Competitors.
- 7. Where are the Opening & Closing Ceremonies taking place?
 - The Opening Ceremony is taking place at BC Place on February 8.
 - The Closing Ceremony is taking place at Rogers Arena on February 16.
 - The Whistler Welcome Celebration (a separate event) is taking place in Whistler at Village Square on February 10^{th.}

- 6. Can we watch the sport competitions in Whistler? Is there a cost / ticket required?
 - All Whistler sport competitions are FREE for spectators.
 - No tickets are required for any of the Whistler sport competitions with the exception of the Alpine Skiing & Snowboarding Novice event where a lift ticket to mid-station is required! (Purchase at any Whistler-Blackcomb Ticket Window or WB Guest Services office).
- 7. Can I watch the sport competitions on TV?
 - The sport competitions will be available for viewing online through Youtube and with daily highlights on TSN.
