OUR OBJECTIVES

Waste Management

- Educate staff and clients to reduce waste, ensuring total annual waste is under 5200 kg.
- Maintain a waste diversion percentage of 90% or better.

Building Operations

- Continue monitoring energy usage, maintaining electrical consumption at or below the BC Hydro baseline.
- Reduce water consumption per person, measured in CBM by 2% over 2014.
- Observe and enforce 'Idle-Free BC'

Administration

- Deliver all collateral, event information, contracts and correspondence electronically or online, unless otherwise requested.

Procurement

- Ensure the Tourism Whistler Procurement Policy is strictly enforced.

TWIGGS (Tourism Whistler Is Going Green Sustainably)

- TWIGGS will meet quarterly, reviewing initiatives, offering ideas and reporting on Waste Audits.

Community

- Share facilities with the community for events and educational initiatives.
